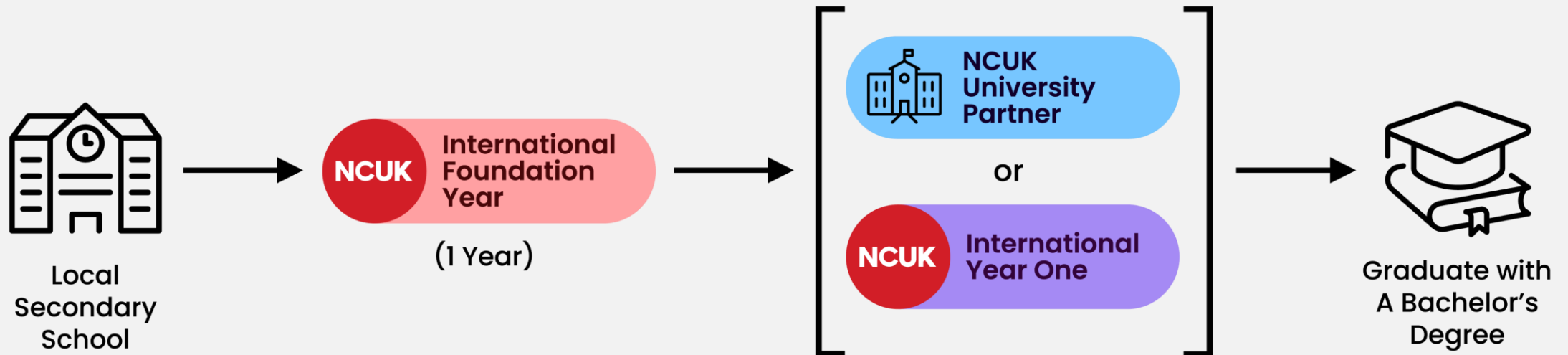

What is the International Foundation Year?



Designed for international students, this programme **bridges the gap between secondary education and university study**, equipping you with essential academic and English skills. It provides **direct entry to over 7,500 degree courses** at **60+ NCUK University Partners** worldwide.

The IFY provides direct entry to the 1st year of a university degree (or entry onto the NCUK International Year One).



Entry Requirements

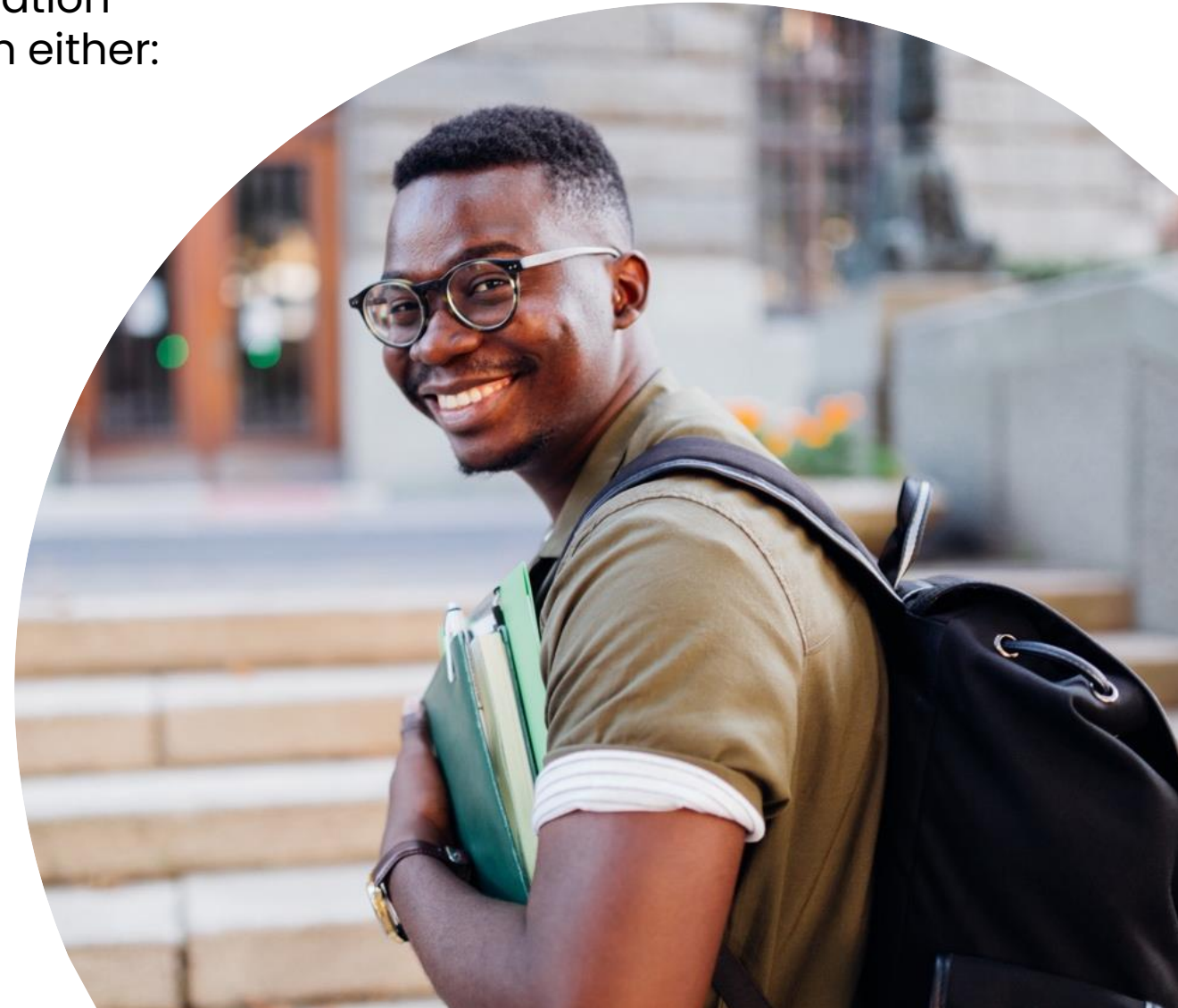
To gain entry onto the NCUK International Foundation Year, you must meet the entry requirements with either:

- Completion of local high/secondary school
- Completion of IGCSE/O Levels/GCSE's with 5 modules at grade 4 or above (normally to include English and Maths)
- You are also required to hold an English language qualification equivalent to IELTS 5.0

NCUK can provide an English test for students to take prior to the course, if they do not already have a result.*

**UK based centres will require a UKVI IELTS test for visa purposes.*

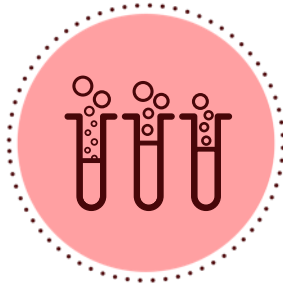

- ✓ understand academic integrity and can demonstrate it in your work
- ✓ have a level of English that enables you to meet the challenges of disciplinary study at university



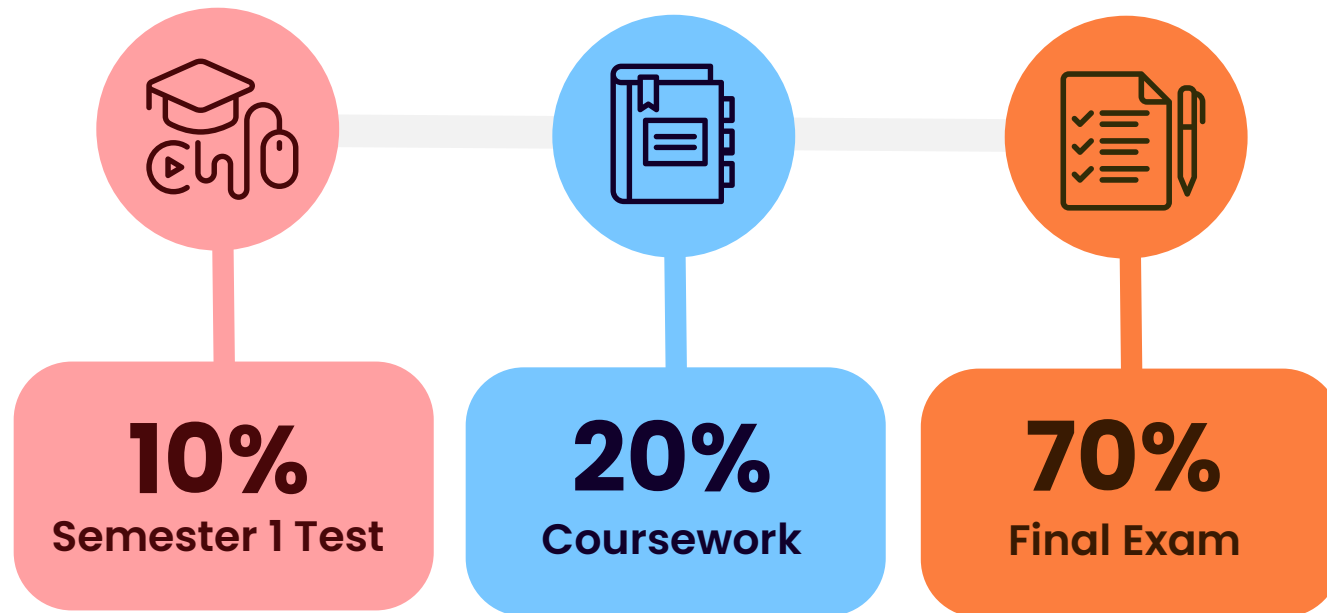
Did you know?

NCUK's English for Academic Purposes is widely accepted by NCUK University Partners as proof of English proficiency, removing the need for additional IELTS tests.

How will I be assessed?

You'll be supported by your teachers and receive feedback throughout the programme to help you do your best. You will be assessed as follows:

Exceptions: Art and Design is 100% coursework. Maths and Further Maths is 30% End of Semester 1 Test, 70% Final Exam

Grading



You will be awarded a grade for each subject module and an overall grade for your EAP module, with grades for each language component.

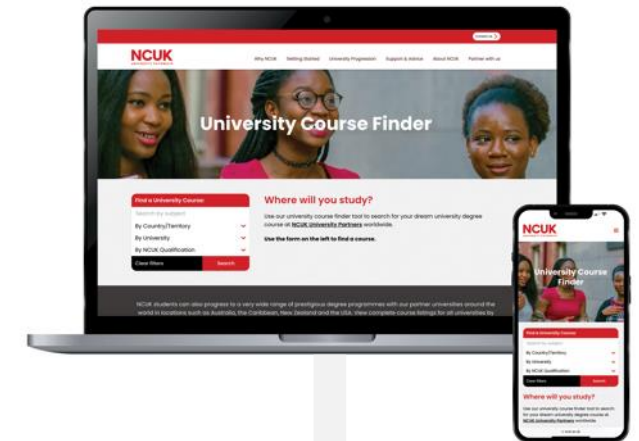

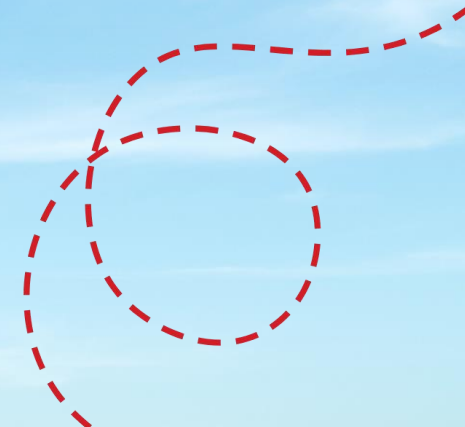
